The team recommended that three (3) out of twenty two (22) buildings inspected, be subjected to a final assessment by the DPWH. The rest were declared safe to occupy.

Please be advised that the said three buildings, **Gusaling Andres Bonifacio, CAS Student Center** and the **fourth floor of the College of Pharmacy** have already been declared safe and regular activities in these buildings may now resume, as certified by the Engineers of DPWH's Bureau of Design and the Manila City Building officials after their inspection on April 24, 2019.
